In **Lions Class** our Key Stage Two children have been focusing on money, using their knowledge of place value to help them add, subtract and find change. They have consolidated what money looks like and that each coin or note has a particular value. We have all studied statistics from discussing best ways to present data in tables, tally charts, bar charts, line graphs or even pie charts. Y3 and 4 have been using their understanding to solve real world problems using graphs and data. Year 5 and 6 have been extending their understanding to timetables, dual bar graphs, multiple line graphs and understanding

Maths at Dolton...

In maths this half term, the children across the school have been learning a range of different mathematical skills and concepts, reflecting on their learning so far and being critical thinkers in order to find answers to various problems or questions.



In **Tigers Class** this half term, our Key Stage One children have been learning about fractions, finding halves and quarters of shapes and amounts. Year 2 have also been finding out about unit and non-unit fractions. This week the children moved on to learning about time, from knowing the days of the read to being able to tell the time to the hour, half hour and quarter past/to the hour.

As marvellous masters of maths, **Little Otters** have been learning all about the number 4, where they can see the number inside and outside of school as well as being able to show the number with their fingers.
