Academic (Wisdom, Knowledge and Skills)

- As speakers, readers and writers we will be revisiting previously studied units on narratives that use dialogue, advanced instructional writing and exploring poetry based on emotions. Children are encouraged to read at home regularly and quiz on their AR books in school.
- As religious and worldview explorers, children in Year 3 and 4 will be exploring the question; How and why do people mark the significant events of life? This will encompass all religious worldviews that they have studied including non-religious. In Years 5 and 6, they will be exploring the question; Why do some people believe in God and some people not?
- As mathematicians, Years 3 and 4 will be learning about time, decimals, money and shape. Whereas Years 5 and 6 will be learning about ratio, algebra, position & direction, statistics and converting units.
- As scientists, all year groups are completing their previous units on space and states of matter before moving on to explore forces and magnets. Years 3 and 4 will be focussing on how things move and how magnets work, whilst Year 5 and 6 will be learning about different types of friction, gravity and creating mechanical advantages.
- As geographers, we will be discovering OS maps, how to use them, what they show and how to use them practically when carrying out some fieldwork.
- As physically active learners, we will be practicing our skills in athletics where we will be focussing on the three main areas: running, throwing and jumping.
- As computer scientists, we will be becoming programmers, looking at how we can program on a computer and also exploring Micro:bits.
